Total award prize of \$830,500 towards to top 15 women and men open finishers, with 1st place \$150,000, secon \$75,000, third 40,000, fourth 25,000, and fifth 15,000, Top 5 masters 1st \$10,000 and top 10 wheelchair 1st \$20,000. Winners awarded additionally \$220,000 towards open record broken, olive wreath, medal and champions trophies.
