26.2 miles course starts Hopkinton, via Ashland, Framingham, Natick, Wellesley (way of 1/2), then, Newton (Heartbreak), Brookline to Boylston St Copley Sq Finish Line.

Winners awarded additionally \$220,000 towards open record broken, olive wreath, medal and champions trophies.

B.A.A.2020, will be the first major marathon to open competitive divisions for ambulatory Para athletes.
